

Beaches & Boulders

This half-day Peninsula tour offers distinctive local experiences in a landscape rich with colour, culture and contrast.

The morning begins with an intimate African Penguin encounter at Boulders Beach, where the colony thrives in a protected coastal habitat framed by rocky silhouettes and sparkling waters.

Kalk Bay's boho seaside charm and kaleidoscopic fishing village are explored at leisure, before a scenic promenade stroll leads guests past St James, famed for its iconic, colourful Victorian-style changing boxes, and through to Muizenberg, the oldest surf town in South Africa.

Beaches & Boulders promises moments that awaken the senses and connect guests to the Cape Peninsula in a deeply personal way.

We recognise that some guests are more “leisure” oriented, so our guides will tailor the itinerary on the day to a pace that invites curiosity and connection. We can do as little or as much walking as your guests would like, whilst still providing an immersive experience that fuses cultural narratives with warm South African hospitality.

BEACHES & BOULDERS

TOUR DESCRIPTION & SUMMARY

- Guests begin their morning at Boulders Penguin Colony, early enough to avoid the worst of the crowds. Nestled between Simon's Town and Cape Point, Boulders is renowned for its African Penguin colony and stunning beaches framed by large boulders and azure waters. Here, amidst a quiet residential area, they can observe these fascinating, iconic birds up close as they roam freely in their protected natural habitat.
- Time in the boho seaside town of Kalk Bay is spent exploring the charming fishing harbour to observe playful Cape Fur Seals; and browsing the quirky antique shops, locally designed clothing stores and vibrant art galleries at leisure.
- With a gentle sea breeze as a constant companion, guests are guided on a lyrically-paced walk along the picturesque seaside promenade to Muizenberg. This stroll offers panoramic views of False Bay, the iconic, colourful beach boxes at St James, and fascinating tales of the history that has shaped this stretch of coast for centuries.
